Narrator: This play is based on a book called Millie and the Mud Hole by Valerie Reddix. It is a story based on a pig who loves the mud.

(Daniel enters and turns to the audience.)

Daniel: Hola. Me llamo Daniel.

Soy un puerco.

Soy gordo.

Narrator: Daniel lived on a farm.

Daniel: Vivo en una granja.

Narrator: Daniel liked the mud.

Daniel: Me gusta el barro.

Narrator: One day, Daniel was very tired.

Daniel: Estoy muy cansado.

Narrator: Daniel found a mud hole that was perfect for a little nap.

Students: Siéntate!

Narrator: He sat in the mud.

(Daniel sits in the “mud.” – an old blanket or shirt painted to look dirty).

Narrator: Along came a rooster.

Rooster: Hola. Soy un gallo. Me llamo Ryan.

(Brian) Vivo en la granja.

Soy rápido.

Me gusta decir “Quiquiriqui!”

(Rooster points at the pig’s toes as the “mud” covers his toes.)

Rooster: Mira a los dedos!

Salga del barro!

Daniel: No, no! Me gusta el barro!

(Rooster shrugs and leaves).

Narrator: Along came a cat.

(Cat enters and turns to audience.)

Cat: Hola. Soy un gato. Me llamo _____.

(Grace) Vivo en la granja.
Soy _____.
Me gusta el leche.

(Cat points at the pig's feet as the "mud" covers his feet).

Cat: Mira a los pies!
Salga del barro!

Daniel: No, no! Me gusta el barro!

(Cat shrugs and leaves.)

Narrator: Along came 2 dogs.

(Dogs enter and turn to audience).

Dog #1: Soy un perro. Me llamo Zack.

(Mina) Vivo en la granja.
Soy rápida.
Me gusta correr.

Dog #2: Soy un perro. Me llamo Max.

(Ben H.) Vivo en la granja.
Soy inteligente.
Me gusta correr.

(Dogs points at the pig's knees as the "mud" covers his knees.)

Dogs: Mira a las rodillas!
Salga del barro!

Daniel: No, no! Me gusta el barro!

(Dogs shrug and leave.)

Narrator: Along came a pig.

(Pig enters and turns to audience).

Pig: Soy un puerco. Me llamo Pinki.

(Kail) Vivo en la granja.
Soy _____.
Me gusta comer.

(Pig point at the pig's stomach as the "mud" covers the stomach.)

Pig: Mira al estómago!
Salga del barro!

Daniel: No, no! Me gusta el barro!

(Pig shrugs and leaves.)

Narrator: Along came a cow.

(Cow enters and turns to audience.)

Cow: Soy una vaca. Me llamo Zack.

(Jack) Vivo en la granja.

Soy _____.

Me gusta comer.

(Cow points at the pig's waist as the "mud" covers their shoulders.)

Cow: Mira a la cintura!
Salga del barro!

Daniel: No, no! Me gusta el barro!

(Cow shrugs and leaves.)

Narrator: Along came a horse.

(Horse enters and turns to audience.)

Horse: Soy un caballo. Me llamo Sophia.

Vivo en la granja.

Soy rápida.

Me gusta correr.

(Horse points at the pig's chest as the "mud" covers his shoulders.)

Horse: Mira al pecho!
Salga del barro!

Daniel: No, no! Me gusta el barro!

(Horse shrugs and leaves.)

Narrator: Along came a chick.

(Chick enters and turns to audience.)

Chick: Soy un pollito. Me llamo _____.

(Audrey) Vivo en la granja.

Soy _____.

Me gusta comer.

(Chick points at the pig's shoulders as the "mud" covers his shoulders.)

Chick: Mira a los hombros!

Salga del barro!

Daniel: No, no! Me gusta el barro!

(Horse shrugs and leaves.)

Narrator: Daniel had sunk so deep in the mud that his nose was now almost completely covered.

Chick and Daniel: Auxilio! Auxilio!

Narrator: The farmers came running.

(Farmer enters and turns to audience.)

Farmer #1: Hola. Soy un granjero. Me llamo _____.

(Nathan) Vivo en la granja.

Soy divertido.

Me gusta manejar.

Farmer #2: Hola. Soy un granjero. Me llamo _____.

(Arjun) Vivo en la granja.

Soy divertido.

Me gusta manejar.

Daniel: Auxilio!

(Farmer #1 grabs Daniel's hand. He/she pretends to pull with no success.)

Farmer #1: Auxilio!

(Farmer #2 grabs Daniel's hand. He/she pretends to pull with no success.)

Farmer #2: Auxilio!

(Duck grabs farmer's hand. All pretend to pull with no success.)

Duck: Auxilio!

(Horse enters and grabs duck's hand. All pretend to pull with no success.)

Horse: Auxilio!

(Pig enters and grabs horse's hand. All pretend to pull with no success.)

Narrator: Daniel really wanted to get out of that mud. They called out again.

Daniel: Auxilio! Auxilio!

Farmers: Mas fuerza!

Animales: Juntos! Uno, dos, tres....

(All pull together.)

Narrator: And Daniel popped out of the mud.

(Daniel acts as if he has been pulled out of the mud.)

Narrator: The animals cheered.

Animales: Hurra! Hurra!

Narrator: And after such hard work, all the animals went to sleep.

Animales: Buenas noches!
